a. Explain your thinking using pictures, numbers, or words.
b. Write a number sentence that shows how you solved the problem.
2. Mimi says you can use addition to solve subtraction.

She says to solve $8-5=$ $\square$ , just add 8 + 5.

Explain how Mimi is right and wrong using words, pictures, and numbers.
3. David is confused about this problem: $\square=7-2$. Be his teacher. Help David understand by writing two addition number sentences that might help him. Solve the number sentences. Explain to David using words, pictures, or numbers, too.
4. At the basketball court, there are 10 friends playing basketball. Some more friends come. Now, there are 15 friends playing.
a. How many friends come to play with the first 10 friends? Explain your thinking using a math drawing, numbers, and words.
b. Write an addition sentence and a subtraction sentence to match the story.

c. Write the addition sentence you found when solving the problem, and use the same three numbers to write three more number sentences:
